HVTC Featured Athlete: Janek Szablinski

Have you ever met someone whom you thought deserved more? Were you amazed to hear how tough their life has been, yet you'd never guess it unless they told you because of their shining presence? There's a glowing respect and honor about them despite the tragedy they've experienced. Well, Janek Szablinski is our Featured Athlete of the Month and he's just that type; strong, humble and courageous. Let's hear his story!

Janek was born in Brooklyn, NY in 1973. He and his family moved upstate to Saugerties when he was young; he attended Saugerties High School, UCCC (Ulster County Community College) and then SUNY New Paltz as a communications major.

However, Janek had to drop-out of college twice due to his father developing cancer and then later his mother. When they passed away, he realized just how short life can be and how many people never get to enjoy the gift of living. Janek's dad was a strong man who fought in World War II and horribly became a prisoner of war; Janek was born when his father was 60. To Janek, his father was a true Iron Man.

Janek lives in his small house in Kingston with two cats. Besides triathlon, Janek's hobbies include snowboarding, going on road trips with close friends and eating triple-bacon cheese burgers at Ruby Tuesday's; it's greasy, messy and soooo good! Pre-requisite; you need two big hands to pick it up! Janek didn't play sports in high school because he worked so much. Not much has changed in that department, either; Janek currently has several jobs; he's a Corrections Assistant in Kingston at an "alternate to jail" program for non-violent felons with drug and alcohol addictions. He's often asked by the "attendees" if he has any addictions; he usually says just one...triathlon. Another job is as a mover in New Paltz; he carries furniture into people's houses, usually up to 5 flights of stairs at a time; this really pumps-up his legs for cycling. Another, he's a Ski Patrol at Hunter Mountain; he assists injured skiers and teaches first aid. Lastly, he does landscaping in Woodstock; Janek works endless hours to fund his triathlon endeavor, but often he's not able to train the way he'd like in order to perform better despite the "training" while on the job. Incredibly, he brings a jump rope to work to stay limber as well as triathlon books and magazines to read during breaks.

His first triathlon was in 2006 at the HVTC Summer Tri-Series in June. The first one was tough; he had a rough day of moving stuff and he was very sore. Nonetheless, he was excited and it was his first time ever wearing a wetsuit. Oh, my! He bought a wetsuit online only to find that the suit was the wrong size! He couldn't breathe and wasn't sure if that was the way it should feel?! Most of his friends think he is nuts for doing tri's and mainly because he registered for an Ironman while still using "floaties" in the pool when training. OH, MY!! Yeah, attempting to convert them to triathlon at the time must have been difficult! He read that the wetsuit should be tight; so he got into the water and practically suffocated. He did the backstroke for most of the way and was able to finish the swim. Two triathlons later (he completed another HVTC race and the NYC Triathlon) he shipped the suit back and bought a sleeveless from a local shop that allowed him to try it on to make sure it was the proper fit. Now, Janek states he's no longer able to blame his slow swim splits on his wetsuit!

Janek saw the Ironman World Championship on television in 2005. He was impressed with how fast the athletes swam, biked and ran. There was also a part of the program that showed folks doing the race for other reasons. It was not about how fast they got to the finish line; it was for something far more important. They raced with their heart. Janek watched a father (Dick Hoyt) transport his son Ricky who has cerebral palsy and is a spastic Quadriplegic for 140.6 miles!! He towed him in a raft for 2.4 miles, then

biked 112 miles with him seated in front of him and then pushed his son in a high-tech wheel-chair for 26.2 miles. Janek was so inspired that he instantly registered for Ironman Florida in 2006. Now, all he had to do is learn to swim and by a bike!! “Yikes, what did I get myself into?!” It all worked-out well as Janek completed the race, but mostly he was just happy to finish; especially the swim portion. When Janek first signed-up for the Ironman, he just wanted to prove to himself that he could overcome something he thought was an impossible obstacle; he did it!

Triathlon is a form of therapy for Janek. It has freed him from a lot of his inner Demons; his partying and late night bar hopping has stopped...okay, slowed down quite a bit! When he races he feels so alive; each time, he's giving his best effort and overcoming his fear of the water. He is still trying to convince his friends to give triathlons a shot and join HVTC. “All the goody bags and great food after the races are such a treat!”

Janek has completed six HVTC Summer Tri-Series races, 4 Kingston Classic 10k's, NYC Triathlon ('06), American Zofingen (long course '06) and Ironman Florida ('06). His goals in 2008 are; Ironman USA Lake Placid in 11+ hours, complete the SOS and avoid being the last finisher at American Zofingen. Janek is grateful to be a part of HVTC...”meeting such nice and determined people. I feel that I have so much to learn and this sport has benefited me in all aspects of my life.” Your father would be proud. Thanks, Janek!

THE GOOD DOCTOR SAYS

Dealing with Handlebar Palsy

Have you ever felt numbness, tingling or weakness in your hands when you have been riding your bike? This common condition is an irritation of the Ulnar nerve and is called Handlebar Palsy, when it effects the Median nerve is actually Carpal Tunnel Syndrome. These nerves supply the fingers of your hand with sensation, and the muscles of the fingers and hand with strength. Overuse from biking by using the same hand position over time, vibration from the road transmitted to the hand, and improper bike fitting, can cause a irritation or pinching of the Ulnar and Median nerves due to the

compressive forces on them. Either of these conditions affects Triathlete's due to the amount of time spent on the bike training. These conditions are worse in persons who spend time on computers, or work with power tools, due to underlying forearm and hand muscle overuse. In the beginning stages the tingling or numbness goes away when you change hand positions. Later stages of nerve inflammation and irritation can cause severe pain, and weakness of the fingers that is not relieved after changing the position of your hands, and can actually be so severe that you might not be able to bike for extended periods of time.

People who suffer from this condition need to switch hand positions every 15 minutes on the bike, or try to weight different parts of the hands. Padded gloves or padding on your handlebars can also help relieve pressure on the hands. Stretches of the Ulnar and Median nerves should be done daily to relieve tightness in the muscles of the forearm and hand. Exercises can be used to strengthen the flexors and extensors of the wrist, hand, and fingers. If the problem persists some form of manual therapy like deep tissue massage, Active Release Techniques®, or Graston Technique® to help break up scar tissue that forms in and around the affected muscles of the forearm and hand.

If you are think you are experiencing symptoms like handlebar palsy that do not go away you should see a sports medicine professional, or a neurologist to get a proper examination of your neck, shoulder, arm, and hand to get an accurate diagnosis. When properly diagnosed a course of treatment can be prescribed and the recovery time is normally 2-4 weeks. As mentioned above, failure to treat this condition, or continued overuse can cause further injury. This could lead to a longer recovery time, decreased training time on, and possibly off the bike.
