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## **Featured Athlete: Tom Gill**

Do you know anyone who's been doing a certain activity for twenty years or more? If so, isn't there a feeling of assuredness and omniscience about how they approach it? It's not a big deal, they've been there done that; and those who've stuck with it for that long are usually void of any need for applause or fanfare. They're doin' it because they love it and it makes them feel good! Our Featured Athlete of the Month, Tom Gill, is one such individual who truly enjoys talkin' triathlon throw-back, about retro-gear or tri-series' you've probably never heard of. It's a gift having an experienced tri-vet in HVTC. Let's hear how it all began.

Tom Gill was born November 30, 1952 and shares the same date with Dick Clark and Mark Twain. He grew up in Flushing, NY and came to the Hudson Valley as a transfer student to Marist College in 1971. He met his wife Barbara at Marist while becoming English teachers and they just celebrated their 32<sup>nd</sup> anniversary. Wow, now that's endurance! They have two kids; Rob, who starts Vassar College in the fall, and Bernadette, who will be a junior at Arlington High School. Barbara and Tom live in Beekman off Route 55; you pass their corner on the way to the Pawling Triathlon every June. Tom began his career as a teacher at the Astor Home with preschoolers who had

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behavior disorders. He's currently the Director of Special Education for Putnam/Northern Westchester BOCES based in Yorktown Heights. The programs serve 450 kids with disabilities from 50 different school districts. Tom's been a school administrator for 27 years and he views his work as a form of social engineering; intending to make communities safe for people with disabilities, women and children. The rest of us have to fend for ourselves!!

As a youngster, Tom wasn't much of an athlete. However, he used to ride his bike all over the place and learned to swim well, too. In swimming, he was an overnight sensation! Tom competed in CYO leagues, specializing in both sprints and long distance. The lack of pools in those days was a limitation for ongoing competition, though, but he kept swimming whenever possible. He began running around 1980, and from reading sports magazines became intrigued with all these guys named Scott; Dave [Scott], [Scott] Tinley, and [Scott] Molina. These were three of the biggest names in the sport of triathlon at the time. So with his new interest in running, it seemed a perfect fit to begin his triathlon career; so he bought a bike and started training.

Tom saw an advertisement for a triathlon in Dutchess County called the Sons of Italy and the swim was being held in "his" local swimming hole. He registered and was devastated when he developed influenza on the day of the race. Ugh!! So, his first triathlon was a year later at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Sons of Italy. In the olden days, most triathletes stripped in the transition area; no tri-suits, just men and women takin' care of business during T1 and T2. In fact, that's how Tom convinced his wife to come and watch a race; "Come on, Honey; you'll get to see lots of naked fit people!!" Yes, it was a sad day for all when the "No nudity in the transition area!" signs went up! The social circle Tom enjoys is void of any triathletes, so it's a solitary endeavor. Although they're not tri fans, Tom is fortunate to hang with his college roommates, participating in a 30 year pinochle game that still is fiercely competitive. Initially everyone thought he was crazy, now they're pretty much used to it; they don't even flinch when he strips anymore!

Tom's done many races in many places; Sons of Italy, Harriman Tri-Series, Allsport Tri-athlon, Westchester Tri, Kure Beach Double Sprint (NC), Fairlee Tri (VT), Vytra TOBAY Tri, Town of Hempstead Point Lookout Tri, Hudson Historical Tri, Albany Tricentennial Tri, Pawling, TRR Biathlon, AZ short Course, Powerman NC, Shamrock Duathlon, Danbury Tri-Series, Pat Griskus Sprint, Bud Light USTS (Mt. Snow, VT), Freedom Tower Aquathlon, Sandy Beach Tri (CT) and the Lake Terramuggas Tri (CT), to name a few! It was at the Fairlee Tri where he met the incredible Ricky and Dick Hoyt; Ricky was born with Cerebral Palsy and his father literally pulls, hauls and pushes his son through many triathlons including the Ironman Triathlon World Championship in Kona, HI. (Please see the '99 footage in Kona for more on them!) Since Tom is a father, he often reflects on that overwhelming display of a man's love for his son.

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Having more than a full time job, a family and doing triathlon have made Tom extremely effective in managing and budgeting his time. The sport is a great stress relief for him. When he thinks back, though, it's where he's been and the things he's seen that make triathlon dear to him. He recalls a moment in the movie *Forest Gump* when Tom Hanks describes to Robin Penn (Jenny) all the amazing things he saw/learned while running. Tom is limited to training for sprints due to time constraints with work. While he probably doesn't think of triathlon more than work, he does build every day around his workouts. (So, what-a-ya-sayin?!) Usually, it's a swim before work and a bike afterwards.

Regarding junk-food/vices, a few years ago when he left a job, his colleagues gave him a year of "Ale in the Mail." Each month, 12 microbrews were delivered to his doorstep for a year! Always thinking of his best interests, they insisted he tell everyone they got him a briefcase. As a result, he's grown quite a taste for India Pale Ales! Tom's also a big Heavy Metal music fan; frequenting the Chance in Poughkeepsie where he's been going to shows longer than he's been doing triathlon. Ah, ha!! Now we know why he can't train for the Olympic distance races; you party animal!! There are set-backs though; he's the oldest person there by 30 years. D'oh! That's gotta hurt.

Tom has had the pleasure of meeting some wonderful people through his athletic travels; he's taken bike lessons from John Howard, running lessons from Jeff Galloway, held Mark Allen's bike for him after a BATC event, and run next to Elvis and all of his imposters at the 1<sup>st</sup> Rock n' Roll Marathon. Despite his charm, Tom is very shy and introverted and the club experience encourages him to relate/connect. The last 2 years, he began to reap the benefits of his endurance endeavors; winning a couple of age group awards. Tom wishes he had HVTC a long time ago! To him, it's a unique community that helped make last year one of his proudest.

The future holds much of the same for Tom. He plans to continue racing at the sprint distance and announcing the moment he passes the 30-year mark in triathlon. Tom would like to thank his children for being a constant source of joy and inspiration, and his wife for that comment 25 years ago or so..."I wish you'd get on a fitness kick!" 'Nough said! Thanks, Tom.
